Hypertufa is a lightweight, manmade stone created to look like weathered tufa stone that is easy and fun to make. It is perfect for creating garden sculptures, troughs, and planters - your imagination is your only limit. It looks like rock, can be cast into almost any shape, is environmentally friendly, very lightweight and can withstand harsh weather conditions.
